What is TRiO Educational Opportunity Center?

TRiO EOC is a federally funded program that assist high school seniors and adults 19 years and older with FREE comprehensive counseling in admissions, financial aid/literacy and career counseling in secondary and/or postsecondary education.

√If you are a high school senior age 16, 17 or 18, and attend an alternative education program or a traditional high school, our program can assist you.

Qualifications to be a TRiO Participant

- ► A citizen or a permanent resident
- ► Resident of Anderson, Oconee, Pickens or Greenville county
- ► First generation college student
- ► Low income
- ▶ In need of one or more of the services provided by the EOC to pursue postsecondary education

You will complete an online INTAKE ASSESSMENT with me.

- ► This will be completed when we schedule our meeting because you need to have all of your documents available.
- ► The INTAKE ASSESSMENT is an application. You are voluntarily applying to be a participant in our program.
- ► It serves as the OFFICIAL DOCUMENT for the federal government letting them know that you are now a TRiO participant.

FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID

Affectionately known as FAFSA https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa



The free application for federal student aid is an online application completed by current and prospective college students to determine their eligibility for student financial aid from the federal government, local state scholarships and grants and institutional scholarships/grants.

Do I have to create a FSA ID?



Your parents need one also!

- ► Log in
- ▶ Phone inquiries
- Your electronic signature
- ➤ Your FSA ID can also be used to access the StudentAid app, sign loan contracts, and access certain information online.

How do I create a FSA ID?

- ► If you have a FSA ID but do not remember your username, select Forgot Username.
- ► Note: If you verified your email address or mobile phone number during
- account creation, you can enter your email address or mobile phone
 - number instead of your username.
- ► If you have a FSA ID but do not remember your password, select Forgot Password.
- ➤ Your password must be between 8 and 30 characters in length, and it must
- contain at lease one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and one number.
 - Special characters are not required, but the following characters
